- ◆ **96%** of participants and caregivers reported being better able to speak up for their healthcare and/or mental healthcare needs

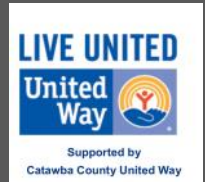
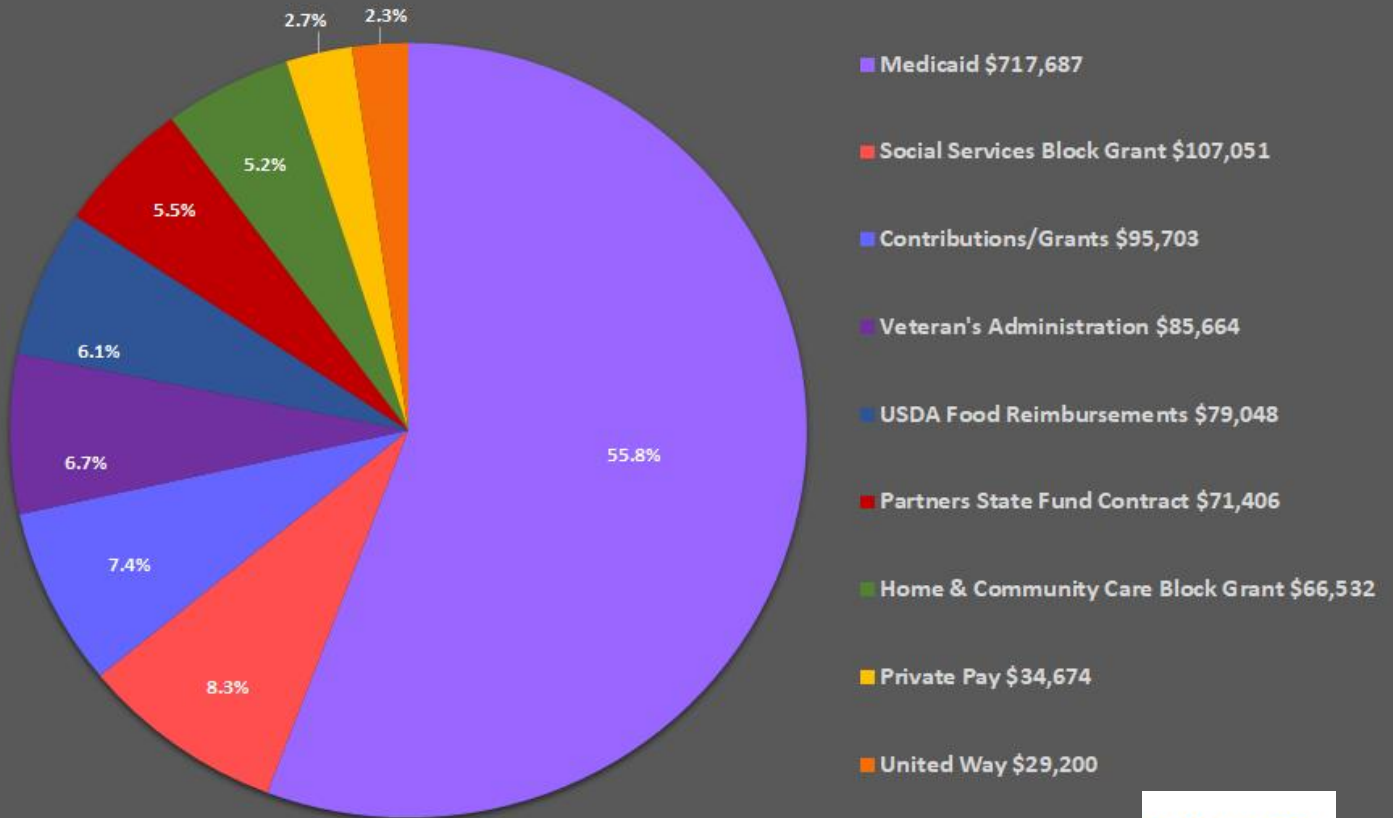


- Adult Life Programs provided services to people living in Alexander, Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, and Lincoln Counties.

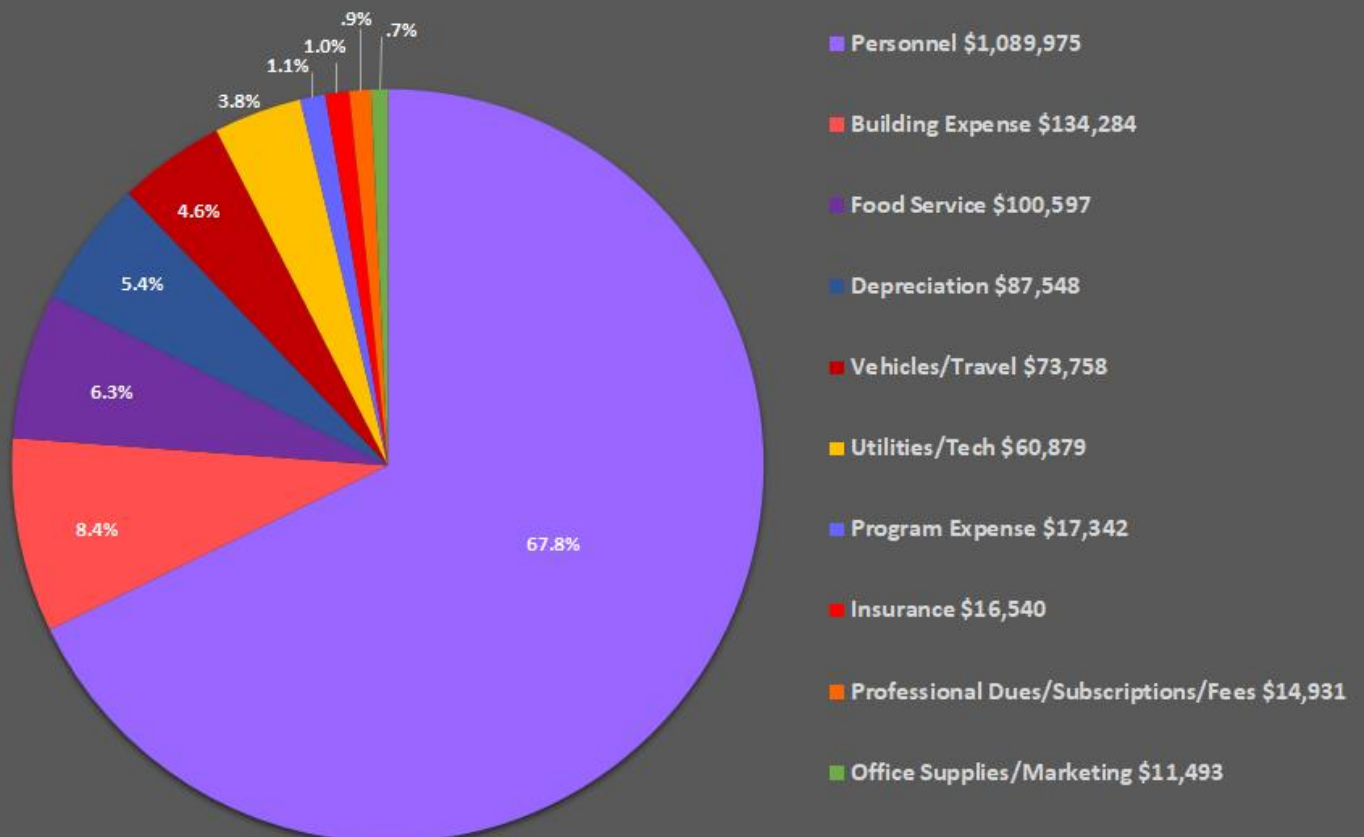
Our Mission:
